

Geon Sunfield Richman Son of John William Richman & Jane Charlotte Sunfield Richman of Paradise Utah

He was released in Jan and they were married in October 15, 1919 in the Logan Temple marriage performed by Joseph R. Shepard (Logan Temple President) bought a home in Paradise - and 1st child was born on Oct 14th 1920. (The day before our 1st Anniversary) Geon's Dad John William always wore a long fur coat and always managed to come around about supper time - ~~loved~~ ^{loved} ~~vegetables~~ ^{fresh Garden Vegetables} loved ~~vegetables~~ ^{attention} ~~vegetables~~. He died a short time later on July 24, 1921 of a heart attack. ^{George} ~~John~~ ^{Richman} ~~Richman~~ was less than a year old at that time. Jane Charlotte ^(Geon's Mother) was very religious and very conscientious yet was always ready to help anyone in need - excellent fire maker.

2nd Child was born on 1, Jul 1926 Geon Thomas and died 3 hrs later - followed before death by Edward O. Memon

3rd Child Lynda Thomas - born on Dec 13, 1928 Boston's Mother died ^{of} a heart attack Aug 2 - 1929 Lived in Paradise ^{Utah} until 1930 & sold home in Paradise & purchased a farm in Blue Creek, Utah. Stayed their only one season, then moved to St. Anthony Idaho. in July 14, 1930 Geon worked with Claude Spauldy with the sheep. Then in 1931 broke in hay in marsh & was laid up until Sept. Geon died July 14, 1935 in St Anthony following a truck accident -
